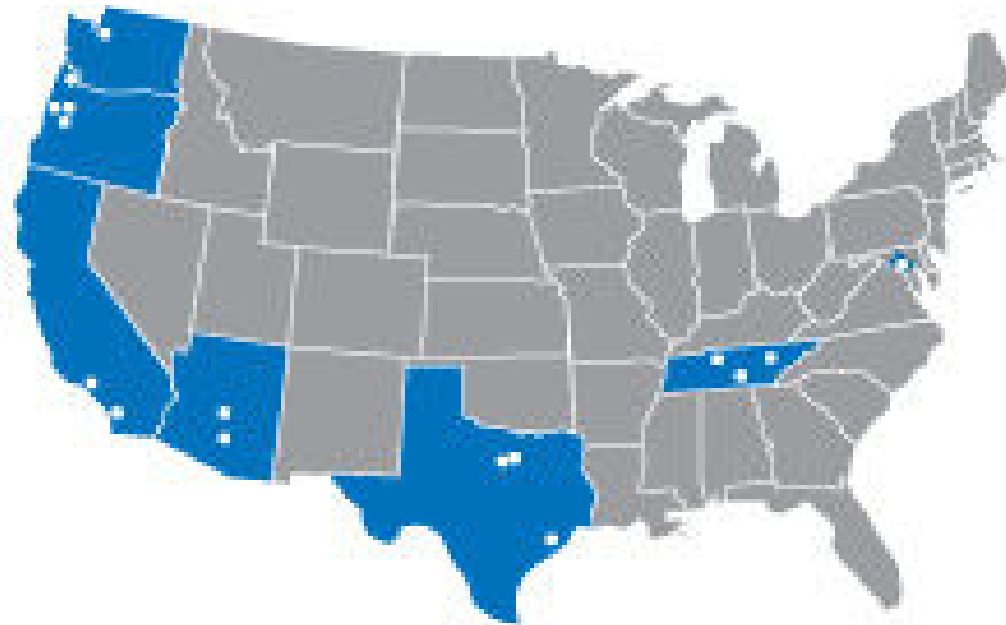


- \$230 million project: American Recovery & Reinvestment Act

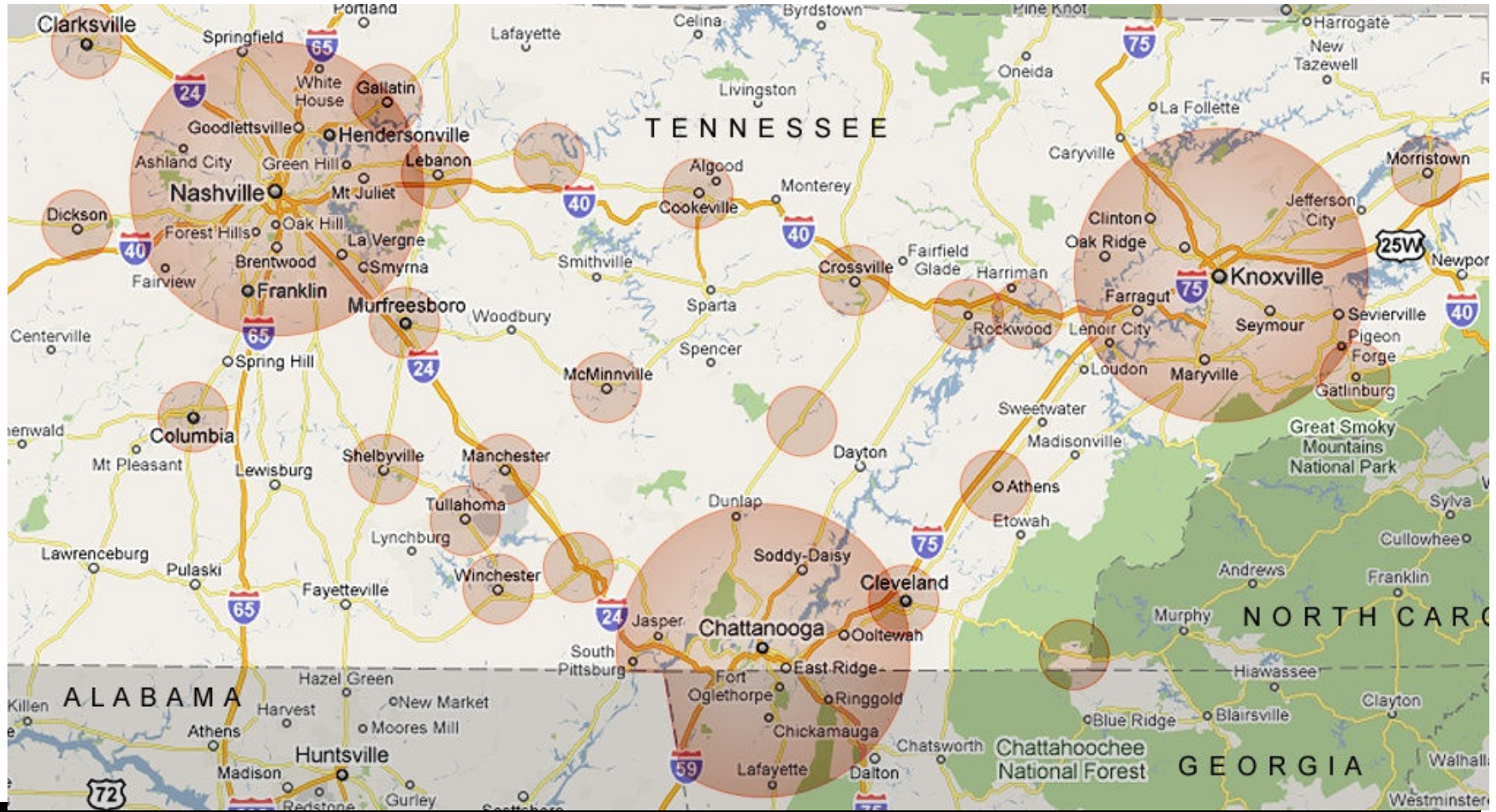
